

Shaking hands

No matter what the occasion, Serbian people will extend their right hand for a long and firm shake.

You don't get a kiss only when you meet for the first time. Every other time, get ready for as many as three kisses (rightleft-right cheek, that's the order), and all that while shaking hands, of course.

Saint Day

Every Serbian Orthodox family has its own Saint Patron and observes it once a year when family and close friends get together to mark the special day and evoke memories of their ancestors.

Orthodox Christmas

Orthodox Serbs observe the Julian Calendar and celebrate Christmas on the 7th January. Christmas day is preceded by a 6-week Lent, followed by festive and colorful celebrations.



How to get to Serbia

By Air

Serbia has three international airports and the main one is Belgrade's Nikola Tesla International Airport (BEG).

There are 32 airline carriers operating in Belgrade: 24 international carriers, 7 low cost carriers and 1 national carrier (Yugoslav Air Transport). Belgrade is directly connected to over 50 major European ports and cities.

By Bus

E-70 and E-75 international routes connect all major towns in Serbia (Belgrade, Novi Sad, Subotica, Nis,...). Belgrade lies along the E-70 and E-75 connecting Western and Northern Europe on one side and Southern and Eastern Europe on the other. Serbia has 40,000 km of roadways, including 600 km of expressways.

By Ferry

.....

Though Serbia is a landlocked country, it offers 587 km (2005) of waterway. Water transport is conducted mostly along the Danube and Sava rivers (Corridor 7). Major ports on the Danube include Belgrade, Novi Sad, Pancevo, and Smederevo.


By Rail

The capital city, Belgrade, has regular and direct rail connections with capital cities in Central and Eastern Europe. International passenger trains include a regular day and night train, the 'Avala', that goes from Belgrade to Budapest, and Vienna.


There are also dailly trains running from Belgrade to Zurich (Switzerland), Munich(Germany), Ljubljana (Slovenia), Banja Luka (Bosnia), Sofia (Bulgaria), Bucharest (Romania), and Thessalonica (Greece).



How to get to Belgrade

By Air

More than 30 international airline companies operate in Serbia. It is possible to book a direct flight from more than 50 destinations in Europe.

Belgrade Nikola Tesla Airport (www.beg.aero) is a modern airport, conveniently located just 15 minutes from the city center, and main conference and accommodation facilities.

Low cost carriers operating in Serbia are: Cimber Sterling, FlyNiki, Germanwings, Norwegian Air Shuttle, Wizz Air, and Air Berlin.

By Rail

An extensive rail network, offering day and night service, connects Belgrade to the rest of Europe. Belgrade main train station is located in the city center, next to the main bus station.

By Bus

Belgrade lies at the intersection of the E-70 and E-75 European highways.

Regular bus coach routes connect Belgrade to the rest of Serbia. International bus coach routes service neighboring countries as well as most European countries.

By Ferry

Belgrade lies on the Danube and Sava rivers. The Port of Belgrade, on the banks of the Danube, is a major transit, loading and cargo center in central Europe. The port features a well- equipped passenger dock on the Sava River, complete with a range of transit facilities.



Traditional Serbian food and homemade brandy (rakia) and wines can be consumed at the typical village house style restaurants and taverns. We strongly recommend the following ethno restaurants: Daca, Kafanica, Srpska brvnara, "?" and Mala fabrika ukusa (C&B recommended).

If you are into river fish specialties, check out Saran (Carp) or Reka (the River) restaurants both located in Zemun, on the right bank of the Danube River.

More into fancy, fusion restaurants where you want to eat well, but also want to see and to be seen? A definite must are: Cantina de Frida, Iguana, Dorian Gray, Zaplet (the

Plot), Madera (C&B recommended). Public - all located in the city center.



Entertainment / Clubbing



Concerts - Belgrade is the capital in every sense of the word. In the cultural sense, Belgrade has hosted concerts of the leading world artists and performers of the classical music, pop or rock scene. The concert venues of the Arena Hall, Sava Centar, the Kolarac Concert Hall, the Student Cultural Center (SKC) are just some of the venues you need to check for new shows.

Art Galleries, Museums, Theatres - Belgrade cultural scene is so rich and packed that it is difficult to make a choice among a variety of art galleries (some of them right in the Knez Mihajlova St), museums, etc. Museum of Contemporary Arts, Ethnographic Museum (one of the oldest museums in the Region), Museum of Nikola Tesla (famous scientist of Serbian origin), National Opera and Theatre at the Republic Square, or Madlenianum Theatre in

Clubbing – Belgrade is Europe's capital of Cool (according to the prestigious UK Sunday Times magazine). It is famous for its vibrant night life. No matter what day of the week, Belgrade never sleeps, offering limitless options for entertainment. On the list of a must see places is the entire **Strahinjica Bana Street** with

charming restaurants and night spots which add to Belgrade's energetic urban vibe

A lot of floating river clubs (Club H2O, Blay Watch, FreeStyler, Gato Verde) make Belgrade nightlife some of the most exuberant in Europe. The clubs or Tube (C&B recommended), Stephan Brown, Baltazar, Magacin are just some of the ideas where you can have great fun.

Shopping



Belgrade offers a variety of shopping opportunities. Large malls are favorite places for shopping and window-shopping. The **Usce Mall** is in close proximity to the city center and is the largest in the Region. The Delta City shopping mall (located in New Belgrade, was named 2009 Best Mall in Europe by the International Shopping-Mall Association) offers numerous stores, supermarkets, restaurants and cafés, food courts, multiplex cinemas, and different opportunities for entertainment.

However, if you prefer combining shopping and sightseeing, dining and entertainment, we recommend the ${\bf Street\, of\, Knez\, Mihajlova}\, ({\bf the\, heart\, of}\,$ Belgrade) as well as the King Aleksandar Boulevard, the longest street in Belgrade (simply called the 'Boulevard').

Did you know that Serbian people are very much into fresh, organic fruit and vegetables? Serbia has been a leading exporter of many domestic grown products (raspberries, plums). Visit the popular green markets, where apart from fresh fruit, you can buy meat and delicatessen at the butcher's, or the most delicious home-made cheese. Make sure to visit green markets of Zeleni Venac, Kalenic or Bajlonijeva Pijaca (just a block off the bohemian quarter of Skadarlija). Grab a hot bun or burek (cheese pie) at one of the many bakeries, or the grilled burger with chopped onions and hot pepper from one of many grill bars.

You can rent a bike or rollerblades and start your sightseeing tour on wheels.

With some 100 restaurants, cafes' and clubs catering to many different tastes and preferences, you can understand

why Belgrade is the "New Capital of Cool" as per the UK Sunday Times. Numerous restaurants – barges line the banks of both rivers. Remember, when you are in Belgrade, there is no limits; you can have fantastic time no matter the day of the week. Belgrade never sleeps!

Another way to experience Belgrade from the rivers is to book a cruise – you will be struck by the beauty of charmingly lit city landmarks during the night

The Vibrant Downtown

••••••

Belgrade is pulsating with life – no matter whether you are here for business or pleasure, you will be amazed with the positive energy this city radiates. To find the street of Knez Mihajlova you won't need the map - all the roads simply lead to the famous street. It is the main artery of Belgrade, and it stretches all the way from the Terazije Square to the fortress of Kalemeddan. It is a pedestrian zone and a shopping center where you will find stores of the world leading brands, art galleries, coffee shops, restaurants, souvenir stalls, and bookstores. Don't worry - everything is open till late night hours. Be prepared to make a stop every now and then to applaud the street performers and entertainers of various kind. Sightseeing can be exhausting -

so, you might consider having a break to try a delicious cake from the rich pallet of the famous café restaurant of "Ruski Car" (The Russian Emperor), or at Gradska poslasticarnica (The City Cake Shop) from where you will enjoy a nice view to the Republic **Square** (the famous rendez-vous point) in the middle of which stands the famous monument of Prince Mihailo Obrenovic. Stop by the National Theater Building where you might book a ticket for the opera or theatrical performance and see what's on at the **National Museum**. Do not miss Kosancicev Venac, the oldest part of Belgrade outside the Fortress of Kalemegdan. If you haven't found the romance yet, you will find it here. Check out why!



Mysteries of Kalemegdan Fortress



Count on needing at least several hours to spare in order to maximize your experience of the Kalemegdan complex, which is placed on the list of the Monuments of Culture of Exceptional Importance. It represents the oldest part of Belgrade which dates back to the first century AD. You will enjoy the ambiance of the old Fortress. Touch a stone, a brick - you'll touch thousands of years of history, life stories, plots, and mysteries. Perhaps one of the greatest mysteries lies hidden within the Roman Well (Rimski Bunar). Unleash the Sherlock Holms within you! You will recharge your batteries in the peace and quietness of the beautiful park, with gardens and trees making fantastic shade during the summer heat. Hop on

a tourist train to make the most of your sight seeing experience. Take a break at one of the restaurants or coffee shops for refreshment, but above all – for the breathtaking view over the rivers, the confluence, and the statue of Victor - the protector of Belgrade, one of the most prominent city landmarks, the artwork of Ivan Mestrovic. It is not without a cause that during the Ottoman Empire rule, the Turks used to call the Kalemegdan 'Ficir bair' which literally means "the Hill for Thinking"

There is fun for animal lovers too, who should not miss the Belgrade Zoo, located in the lower part of the Kalemegdan, covering the area of 7 hectares with 2,000 animals of 270 species.

Bohemian Skadarlija

This authentic part of Belgrade downtown core has kept up the tradition of old times and has remained a true inspiration for poets, painters, actors, artists in general, politicians, lawyers, lovers, and anyone who praises good food, and nice music. Visit some of its famous taverns with picturesque names: Tri sesira (The Three Hats), Kod dva bela goluba (The Two White Pigeons), **ľma dana** (There's Time), **Šesir** moj (This Hat of Mine) and get ready for the most enjoyable experience of live music

'starogradska' – which literally means the old city music, a genre that represents urban traditional folk music of Serbia. Stroll down (if you are still able to do so after a few drinks of Serbian slivovitz) the cobbled street to pick up a souvenir or two for a remarkable memory from Belgrade. You are most likely to bump into the performers dressed up in traditional costumes evoking the atmosphere of old, bohemian times.



Serbian Spirituality and Orthodoxy



To visit Serbia and not to visit at least some of Serbian Orthodox churches, would mean missing a chance to get to know Serbian people and Serbian tradition.

The Temple of Saint Sava (Hram Sv. Save) - dominates Belgrade cityscape and presents one of the largest Orthodox churches in the world. It is located just above the vibrant Slavija square. This remarkable domed building with its white marble and granite facade is dedicated to the Saint Sava, founder of the Serbian Orthodox Church.

Ruzica Church – built in stone, as a part of the Kalemegdan

fortress, the first Orthodox church in Belgrade and one of the 10 most unique churches in the world thanks to its 'trench art'.

St. Michael the Archangel Church (Saborna crkva) – built in 1840 in the style of classicism with late baroque elements. The gold-plated carved iconostasis is a masterpiece in the rich decoration of the interior.

St. Mark's Church (Crkva Sv. Marka) - located in the center of Belgrade, in the tranquility of the beautiful Park of Tasmajdan. It was built from 1931-1940 in the Serbian/Byzantine style.

Ada Lake – Leisure Paradise

This is an island in the Sava River, at just a few kilometers away from the city center. According to the Virtual Tourist Survey, it has been ranked 3rd on the list of world city destinations. The lake is used both for recreation and sports offering more than 50 sport terrains for different disciplines. Biking or roller skating on the superb trails around the lake will be a memorable experience, while golf lovers will enjoy a 35 hectares course with 180 meters shooting range.

For **team building** activities consider foam football, trim trails with very versatile configuration,

or simply **barbecuing** in the beautiful ambiance of the park. Ada safari, water skiing, adventure park, bungee jumping, and free climbing will attract the adrenaline junkies.

Ada Resort has as many as 70 different restaurants and cafés open throughout the year. Many of them are night clubs with live music, an excellent choice for relaxation after a long business day. The newly refurbished Jezero restaurant (the Lake) situated on the left bank is a fantastic choice if you wish to plan an event for as many as 1,000 people.



Zemun - Roman Taurunum



During the Roman times it used to be called Taurunum; now it is a part of Belgrade and lies on the right bank of the Danube River. The hill of Gardos is one of the three hills of Zemun. Its narrow cobbled streets will take you to some very cozy café restaurants with amazing views on the Danube River. The **Tower** of Gardos was built in 1896 and is a place to take a break for a memorable snapshot. During the summer months the plateau of the Tower becomes the stage for numerous cultural performances. Once in Zemun, book a ticket for the Madlenianum Opera and Theater. You can also consider holding an event in one of the

meeting rooms equipped with state-of-the-art audio-visual

components.


The Danube River has always been associated with Zemun. The old settlers usually have a fishing boat and enjoy maintaining it while telling fisherman stories. You will be delighted by the city center and its pedestrian zone packed with cafés and cozy restaurants. Get some rest in the Zemun Park, or take a stroll along the Danube promenade, which will take you all the way to the confluence of the two rivers. The numerous restaurants are all lined up along the quay. Avala – the Beauty of Belgrade



Danube Sightseeing – be sure to book a tour on a boat restaurant for a unique cruising experience along the Danube River.

Night clubs and bars – those who like clubbing will have a terrific time in the Petrovaradin Fortress, where you can choose from a variety of bars and clubs. **The Jelisavetin Bastion** (the Bastion of Jelisaveta) is a favorite place of regular clubbers where one will enjoy unforgettable DJ concerts and theme parties in the authentic space of the Fortress. Another trendy place is the Museum, one of the most elegant discotheques in Novi Sad. Downtown is always in the street of Laze Teleckog in the downtown pedestrian zone is packed with cafe's, bars, and restaurants. One such place is Marta's Pub, while The London Club with its brick walls and wooden floors will be the perfect

spot for the winning combination of draft beer and the 80s and 90s rock music hits. Trcika is an authentic old tram café – named after the first tram of Novi Sad, while Foxtrot is the perfect choice for jazz and blues fans. The **Giardino** is a large club with modern décor located on the roof-top of the Bazar shopping mall. If you are a jazz fan, do not miss **The Wheels** club with its laid back atmosphere and excellent performers. The Skipper Boat restaurant on the Fisherman's Island is the place where you will be closest to the river Danube. Goose (Gusan), located in one of the cities most beautiful passages, is the first restaurant in Novi Sad. Through time, it has kept its authenticity and tradition - this is the place where you will feel at ease with the draft beer, served with chicken wings.



Shopping



Dunavska and Zmaj Jovina streetsboth in the center of Novi Sad. This is where you can find a variety of open terrace cafés, pastry shops, restaurants, bookstores, and stores. If you are into handmade leather products, we strongly recommend the **Manual** store.

Liman Green Market – an urban market place where you can buy fresh and organic fruits and vegetables, dairy products and meat, and will feel the vivid atmosphere of the place. One tip - don't forget to bargain.

Enjoy the Danube



Sometimes referred to as 'the Blue Highway', the Danube has always been very important to Novi Sad serving as the communication bridge between cultures, bringing trade activities to the area, fishing, as well as tourists craving to experience something new and beautiful. The Danube in Novi Sad offers various types of experiences, each exciting and beautiful on its

Strand – the most beautiful beach in Novi Sad, packed with people and positive vibrations, especially in the summer months, when you can enjoy swimming and active leisure on the white sandy beach. Never heard of 'head tennis'? Well, this sport discipline is distinctive to Strand, and you should definitely try it out. Or, how does beach volleyball tournament sound to

you? The options are endless. And when you want to chill out, cafés and restaurants are there for you. These places turn wild at night with live music and entertainment well into the wee hours the next day.

Fisherman Island – a tourist complex in a peaceful area. in close proximity to the city center, yet far enough to enjoy the Danube River, peace and quietness of the nature. Several restaurants are located on the Island, including the Fisherman Restaurant, with the capacity of up to 500 seats and a garden that can be customized and configured to perfectly meet all your needs such as: wedding receptions, family celebrations, cocktails, and so on. You will be delighted by the river fish specialties.

The Heart of the City

Again it is about the Danube River. This river bears so much importance to the city, that it is no wonder why it is a part of so many toponyms. The street of Dunavska is the pedestrian and shopping district, and the center of cultural events. You can visit the Museum of Vojvodina and the **Historical Museum** while strolling down the Street, which finishes with the Danube Park, where you can have a rest away from the humdrum of urban life and truly enjoy nature, the lake and surroundings. The Liberty Square is the main square, where you will feel the vividness of the town. The big statue of Svetozar Miletic, one of the most

prominent Serbian politicians of the 19th century, dominates the square, as well as the **City Hall** built in the Neo-Renaissance style. The biggest gallery in the city is the Gallery of Matica Srpska, the most prominent Serbian cultural institution. Zmaj **Jovina** is one of the main streets in the Old City. Named after the famous poet Jovan Jovanovic Zmaj, it is packed with various cafés and boutiques. Its most important building is at the very end of the street - the Bishop's Palace (Vladicanski Dvor). One of the most popular meeting points is the street of Laze Teleckog packed with restaurants, cafés, and good vibe.

The Fairytale of Petrovaradin



The Fortress is located on the right bank of the Danube River. Built between 1692 and 1790, it covers an area of 112 hectares, with 16 kilometers of underground corridors and catacombs. The Fortress is one of the most prominent landmarks of Novi Sad. The location and the breathtaking view are so wonderful that many artists have found their inspiration right here, thus making the Petrovaradin Fortress the ideal place to house numerous art galleries. Visit Studio 61 where workshop showcases artistic tanestries The Museum of Novi Sad houses one of the largest systems of underground galleries in Europe. The guide will take you through

the amazing network of military galleries – you will be thrilled by the mysterious experience. Don't get confused when you see the Old Clock Tower on the Fortress – its small hand tells the minutes, while the big hand shows the hours – this was done on purpose so that the citizens of Novi Sad and sailors along the Danube could see the time from afar.

In the summer time, the Fortress hosts the famous music festival EXIT. The superb 5-star hotel Leopold situated in the heart of the Fortress, with a spectacular view over the city, can be a place where a nice meeting can be organized, followed by a memorable dinner.

All Roads Lead to EXIT

EXIT represents the biggest music festival in South-East Europe. It is held in the beautiful ambiance of Petrovaradin Fortress, during the first half of July. The city of Novi Sad then becomes the center of the world. Positive energy, urban vibe and cosmopolitan spirit permeate the city. The Festival attracts visitors from all around the world, who come to enjoy extra quality musical program,

top world performers, fabulous entertainment, and the positive energy of Novi Sad. The four-day program is scattered on as many as 22 stages. It would take 51 days for one person to listen to the whole program. For the ones who truly want to grasp the full essence of the Exit festival, the Exit village offers the camping facilities – terrific environment to hang out with other campers and festival goers.



Multi Cultural Spirit



What is so special about Novi Sad is its multiculturalism which is reflected through various spheres of social life, ethnic tolerance, architecture and multiconfessionalism.

Religious Buildings. Serbian Orthodox Church (Saborna crkva) is in close vicinity of the Bishop's Palace. It is the most important Orthodox Church in Novi Sad. The famous Epiphany Cross made of pink marble is the oldest preserved monument of Novi Sad and is kept on the Church Porch. The Name of Mary Church, simply referred to as the "Cathedral", is located at the Liberty Square. Beautifully decorated in Neogothic style, it represents one of the most prominent buildings in the city.

The Synagogue. Built in 1909, this beautiful building is no longer used for religious ceremonies. Today it is used as the venue for many cultural concerts and events. The building is one of the landmarks of Novi Sad and is considered a monument of great importance.

Vojvodina Typical

Farmsteads (salashi) —located in the vicinity of Novi Sad, they represent country estates from the 18th and 19th centuries. You can grasp the feeling of village life in Vojvodina, while enjoying excellent and hearty homemade meals, local music and horse rides. We recommend the farmsteads of Cenej (for example the '137 salash'), or the Begec farmsteads.

Czarda. It has become the true brand of Vojvodina. These unique taverns offer superb food, warm

atmosphere, and – in most cases – accommodation. Usually located in the midst of an oasis of peace and quietness, by the Danube River, czardas are the perfect places to recharge your batteries and fully recuperate. Check out the "Kucerak kod cesme" (The Hut by the Fountain) on Fisherman Island. Another recommendation is the Dunavac czarda where you will be amazed by the traditional fish stew, in the warm and cozy environment of this amazing surrounding.



The Charm of Sremski Karlovci



Located about 15 minutes from Novi Sad, Sremski Karlovci with its predominantly baroque style, is the town-museum. Many historical buildings will overwhelm you with their beauty and significance. In 1699 the town hosted the meeting that ended the hostilities between the Ottoman Empire and the European Powers. The Treaty was signed at the Peace Chapel, at the round table - that was the first time that round table was used in international politics. The town of Sremski Karlovci was once the center of Serbian spirituality and education. The first Šerbian (and Slavic) Grammar School was founded in Sremski Karlovci in 1791.

Strolling down the narrow, picturesque streets of the Town, you'll come across the oldest Serbian bookstore and pharmacy. For wine lovers, **Bermet**, the authentic wine of the area is a must try. Another great place to see is the **Beekeeping Museum**.

When in Sremski Karlovci, you certainly do not want to miss a visit to one of the famous picnic spots - the Strazilovo. The complex is intertwined with trail paths for a superb hiking experience. Climb up the hill and you will see the monument dedicated to Branko Radicevic, famous Serbian poet. Have a meal and well deserved rest at the 'Brankoy Cardak'.

The Holy Mountain of Fruška Gora

Just 20 km from Novi Sad, the National Park of Fruska Gora is the real jewel of Vojvodina. The mountain of Fruska Gora, allso known as the **Holy Mountain** (just like the Holy Mountain of Áthos or Sinai), regroups 17 Orthodox monasteries that date back to the 14th century. These monasteries have been declared Monuments of Culture of Exceptional Importance in Serbia. Some of them are as old as the 14th century. Make sure to visit at least some: Vrdnik, Hopovo, Krusedol, Grgetek, Velika Remeta, and many others. During your visit, take a moment

to contemplate in silence the scent of incense, the solenity of the place and the beuty of the icons and fresco decorations. The experience will bring you the long-sought inner peace you have been longing.

Fruska Gora is also famous for its **vineyards** and **great wines**, rare plant and wildlife, nature reserves, and mountain lakes.


The places of interest are also the picnic destinations of **Iriski Venac** and **Brankovac**.

SUBULICA

Subotica Art Nouveau



This will be love at first sight. The moment you approach the city center, you will be overpowered by the beauty and harmony of Subotica's architecture, colors, shapes and spirit. The predominant architectural style is Art Nouveau with its most prominent building being The City Hall (Gradska kuca), built in 1912. It is the true symbol of Subotica. You do not want to miss climbing 80 meters up the Clock Tower to reach its observation deck for an amazing view of Subotica and its surrounding countryside. The City Hall also houses banks, restaurants, gift shops and the Municipal

museum, and is surrounded by large Green (1985) and Blue (2001) fountains, both decorated with famous Zsolnay ceramics.

The Raichle Palace (Rajhlova palata), built in 1904 by architect Ferenc Raichle, it is certainly one of the most beautiful buildings in Subotica. Today it houses a Modern Art Gallery, that is open to visitors. Korzo Street - This centric street is maybe the most beautiful in the city. This is a pedestrian zone, with plenty of stores, restaurants and bars where you will enjoy picturesque details and friendly atmosphere.

Multi-Ethnic Spirit

Subotica is characterized by its multi-ethnic spirit where different communities live together in peace and tolerance, respecting each other's heritage, customs and tradition. The presence of different religious buildings speaks in favor of this fact.

The Cathedral, built in 1779, in late Baroque style, is dedicated to St. Teresa of Avila, the patron of Subotica. It is commonly referred to as the Grand Church.

The Orthodox Church, built in 1726 on the highest point of the former old town is dedicated to the Holy Ascension of the Lord.

The Synagogue was designed by the same architect who designed the City Hall. The building, built in 1902 in Art Nouveau style, enjoys special status, and is listed a cultural monument of great importance.



Lake Palic Paradise



••••••

Just 8 km from Subotica, Palic deserves its place on a tourist map as it represents one of the most popular destinations in Serbia. At the turn of the 19th century, Palic used to be a resort and spa where elite used to converge. It has retained its old charm and today it is a modern resort with luxurious hotels, congress center, villas, restaurants, night clubs, sport facilities, three beaches, and a zoo among other things. The resort is ideal for unforgettable team building and incentive programs. The lake has nice and cozy beaches along its 17 kilometers long shores, and offers various opportunities for waters sports and fishing. Picturesque villas and boutique hotels have become popular

excursion point for tourists. The main promenade begins at the Water Tower which is one of symbols of the Palic resort (built at the beginning of the 20th century as a multipurpose facility: a water tower, gate of the resort and a tram station). The visitor is then taken to the Grand Terrace. a beautiful Art Nouveau building from the beginning of the 20th century when it was used for entertainment and balls. Close by is the Women's Lido, a fairy-tales resembling restaurant with local ethnic details, where you can relax while sipping your favorite drink. The **Summer Stage** is situated in the heart of the Park. It becomes extremely vivid in the summer months when it hosts the traditional European Film Festival Palic.

Zoo Palic

Zoo Palic is said to be one of the most beautiful zoos in this part of Europe. It represents an oasis where you will truly enjoy nature, 270 wood and shrub species and more than 65 animal species. The garden is so neatly arranged that you will enjoy relaxing in the peace of the surroundings.

Coffee shops and a restaurant offer the utmost satisfaction. It is also possible to organize a meeting event at the Zoo building, that is fully equipped with audio-visual system to satisfy the most demanding needs.



Horse Riding Adventures



It is the largest horse farm in Serbia, close to the town of Subotica. The entire resort has an artificial lake (if you are a fishing fan, you will love this), traditional style houses, hectares of green surfaces and nicely arranged wood lanes. Above all, Kelebija is a horse farm with modern stables, pastures and trails for competition - all this ambiance is a paradise for both the visitors and the horses. The guide will take you for a tour, revealing the history of the **Lipizzaner horse** breed, and the collection of more than 30 horse carriages. Here you can enjoy horseback riding and a beautiful carriage ride. The farm is the ideal place for a wide range of team-building activities. If you happen to visit Kalebija in

winter months, you should not miss the **sledge ride**. The farm is the ideal place for a wide range of team-building activities. With its meeting capacities, the farm is a great option to hold seminars or similar type events. Villa Majur, with its facilities and pleasant atmosphere is a perfect choice for your event.

Furioso Horse Center. Get 'furious' and raise your adrenalin level riding a horse with your colleagues from work! The center offers a variety of possibilities for teambuilding, incentives as well as creative workshops. Organize a meeting in the beautiful ambiance of a thatched conference hall.

Enjoy the Farmsteads

These farms are typical of the Vojvodina. They are usually located in the beautiful meadows of Vojvodina, away from the village, and consist of a house, and several maintenance buildings, and a horse stable. Today, these farms are real resorts and they have been adapted with modern facilities like swimming pools, sports terrains, and fishing ponds to accommodate visitors. In some estates though, the families still live the lives of their ancestors. Those that are adapted to cater to tourists, offer traditional food and vines, accompanied by superb hospitality.

Majkin Salas (Mother's Farmstead) – located on the outskirts of Palic, represents an oasis that is stretched to 20 hectares of land; the restaurant offers a variety of homemade specialties (potato pie, chicken stew, salas beans, sheep stew with cabbage, Vojvodina domestic strudel, and many others). You can also witness how locals prepare the dishes, sausages and other specialties.

Jelen Salas (Deer Farm Farmstead) – close to Palic Lake, is surrounded by woods and beautiful plains. It offers authentic ethno ambiance, evoking good memories of the old times. The chef will be happy to show you the process of traditional cooking. However, the final touches of the recipes remain a secret! Both of the farmsteads can host more than 400 people each.



Care for Some Wine?



The region of Subotica lies on sand, as the remnant of the pre-historic Panonian sea. This type of terrain coupled with mild climate has contributed to the specific quality of wines called 'the sand wines'. The wines of Subotica are among the most famous in the region. The traditionally cultivated autochthonous sorts are

Kadarka and Kovidinka. Other sorts of white and red wines are also successfully produced, especially the White Burgundy, Riesling, Merlot, Red Burgudny and Cabernet. Do not miss to visit some of the wineries for wine tasting and purchasing: Wine Castle (Vinski dvor), Cuvardic Wine Farm, DiBonis.

The Sombor Tour

Sombor is a town located some 60 km from Subotica and Palic. This picturesque town with its baroque style center is a destination to include on your travel itinerary. Its rich history has left numerous traces in the way Sombor looks today. Some of the oldest higher education institutions are located right here - The Teacher's College founded in 1778 is the oldest college in Serbia and the Region. For other places of interest, do not miss the **National Theatre**, the Regional Museum, the Modern Art Gallery, as well as the Town Museum displaying a permanent exhibition of the works of Serbia's famous painter Milan Konjovic.

A very special trademark of the town is the **fiacre ride** (horse carriage) driven by coachmen in special attire, evoking the spirit of older and simpler times.

Another trademark of the town is the 'Somborski kotlic' (Sombor fish pot), a gastronomic manifestation held in July by the Saint Trinity Square where more than 300 participants compete in preparing the best fish stew. This event attracts numerous visitors, who come to enjoy the fantastic stew, and the cultural program and traditional music of tamburitza organized for the occasion.







Restaurants / Dining – Where and what to eat?

When in Zlatibor, you have different options to satisfy your taste buds. If you are into contemporary cuisine, you won't make a mistake if you choose any of the fancy restaurants, pizzerias or pancakes shops. Definitely you don't want to leave Zlatibor without trying at least some of the typical specialties in ethno restaurants in the old villages of Sirogojno, Mackat (National House Bajo), or Zlakusa (Terzica Avlija). We can also recommend the 'Krcma-Gaj', the 'Zlatiborski Pastuv (the Zlatibor Stallion), Zlatni bor (the Golden Pine), Miris dunja (the Quince Scent). The pallet of the specialties you should try is wide, however be sure not to miss the following:

Kajmak (kaymak) - Fresh and unripened cheese made from unpasteurized, unhomogenized milk. Depending of the length of the fermentation process, it can be very mild to very strong in taste (aged kaymak) and rather yellowish in color. It is usually served with bread as an appetizer, or with specialties such as a hamburger (pljeskavica sa kajmakom), or with cevapcici (kebabs

'Komplet lepinja' - Made with special type of bread called somun, served with a scrambled egg and a layer of kaymak, sprinkled with lard after

roasting, and baked in the oven for about 10 minutes.

Gibanica - Cheese pie made with home made pastry dough and a very special type of cheese, or aged kaymak. It is usually served with yoghurt, either creamy or very firm.


Prsuta (prosciutto) - The processing of dry-cured meat in Zlatibor has remained the same throughout the centuries. The specific climate of Zlatibor, the altitude and the humidity are the factors which add to the refined taste of the Zlatibor prosciuto. Thin slices of Zlatibor prosciutto served with kaymak, coupled with a local drink of sljivovitz make a perfect hors d'oeuvre.

Kacamak (polenta) - Porridge made of white maize flour with an abundance of cheese. It is served with cream or buttermilk.

Hejldopita (buckwheat pie) – Special type of pie made with buckwheat flour, the cereal typical of the Zlatibor region. The pie is made with cheese and served with yoghurt.



Entertainment / Clubbing



In Zlatibor, there are two artificial lakes. The larger one on the Crni Rzav River in Ribnica is a real paradise for fishing, while the smaller one in the center of Zlatibor, in King's Waters, was created for tourists to enjoy in the summer months.

Daily **cultural events** are organized throughout the summer season. Concerts, festivals, exhibitions, and art colonies represent unique opportunities to get acquainted with Serbian tradition.

Apart from the outdoor fun and recreation, Zlatibor offers a variety of different possibilities for visitors to

enjoy clubs and restaurants. Some of the best restaurants with contemporary cuisine as well as the **night clubs** are located either on the banks of the lake, or close to the center.

Zlatibor is famous for its night life. Depending on your preferences and music inclinations, you should check out at the Irish Pub, Vendome, Sunset, Apollo, Vizantia or the Baron.



Shopping



In the center of Zlatibor you will find different well stocked stores and supermarkets. But, for the unique shopping experience, you simply cannot leave Zlatibor without purchasing some of the items typical of the area.

•Sirogojno sweaters and knitwear

-These hand-knit garments: (sweaters, scarves, gloves, caps - all designed with local motifs) have brought Sirogojno the brand name. The village is now a popular stop on the world tourism map. The 'Sirogojno Company' has a permanent exhibition where you can buy nice sweaters as well as **organic** dry fruit. In Sirogojno you can also visit the **souvenir store**. The village also has a small, picturesque **green** market place.

If staying at Kraljeve Vode (King's Waters) you can go to the market place (open daily) where you will be able to buy nice presents and souvenirs/products:

- •Prosciutto
- •Cheese and kaymak (cheese spread) •Herbal teas (Zlatibor is famous for its rich selection of prime herbs and teas)
- •Rakija (home-made brandy)
- •Honey (Zlatibor is famous for its natural, organic honey)
- •Jams and marmalades (home-made, and organic)

When visiting the village of **Zlakusa** you will be able to choose from a variety of souvenirs and products that this place is famous for - the traditional art of pottery.

ZLATIBOR

King`s Waters



This is in the heart of the Zlatibor District. You won't be wrong if you call it King's Waters (Kraljeve vode) since it used to be called as such after the arrival of Aleksandar Obrenovic, the King of Serbia, to Zlatibor in 1893. A fountain had been erected in his

Today, King's Waters represents a tourist complex with the largest accommodation capacities in Zlatibor. It houses a variety of hotels, restaurants, congress halls and meeting rooms. It has been a popular recreation camp for various sporting groups. There are also numerous opportunities for paragliding, tennis, skiing and swimming.

Ski Center Tornik

If you are into winter sports, you should not miss the Tornik center, a modern ski resort with four ski slopes: Tornik slope (1496 m above sea level), Cigota (1422 m), Ribnica and Zmajevac. For new beginners and children, the gentle slopes of Obudovica are just fine. Cross-country and biathlon are a real joy, too. The center is equipped with the artificial snowing system that

helps the skiing season run much longer.

The lifts operate throughout the year, so even if you are not a skiing fan, you can take a ride to the peak from where you will be able to see the beautiful landscape of Serbia. Take a deep breath, clear your lungs, and 'seize the day'!



The Old Village of Sirogojno



Make sure to book a trip to the nearby picturesque village of Sirogojno which lies at 900 m altitude. This authentic Serbian mountain village has been declared a Cultural Monument of Exceptional Importance in Serbia. It has gained world popularity because of the famous handmade sweaters and knitwear with motifs of the Zlatibor area. Check-out the event calendar to make sure when to participate in some of the traditional crafts workshops (pottery, knitting, wool-processing, blacksmith, cooper, and others).

In Sirogojno, you will be able to visit the **Open Air Museum - Old**

Village Sirogojno. This unique museum displays, over an area of 5 hectares, a series of traditional houses made of wood, including a bakery, a dairy, as well as an inn, where you can try roast lamb, locally prepared beans, and a variety of pies, all served with traditional drinks. In the authentic ambiance of the hall you will be able to organize an event for about 100 people. It is possible to book accommodation in the cottages that have kept the traditional appearance and feel, but that have been adapted to accommodate the needs of a modern visitor.

Wooden Town / Küstendorf

Wooden Town is the legacy of the famous movie director Emir Kusturica. While shooting his movie "Life is a Miracle", he could not resist the beauty of the village of Mokra Gora on the hill of Mecavnik. He decided to build his own Wooden Town that consists of wooden cottages designed in the traditional style and structure.

Wooden Town has, like any other town, a library, an artist gallery, a modern cinema with 100 seats, a sports hall, a national cuisine restaurant, as well as a cake shop where you can taste the home-made sweet pies. The hotel disposes with several meeting rooms and accommodation capacities, thus making it possible to organize an event in this fairytale setting. Every year, in the first half of January, the Wooden Town hosts the Küstendorf International Film and Music Festival. Don't get surprized if you bump into Johnny Depp, or some other celebrity.



Sargan's Eight Train



One of most attractive tourist railway museums in Europe, this famous railway curves its way through the beautiful, steep landscape and slow uphill, bending around its slopes and forming the shape of number eight. The rail is 15.5 km long and it goes through 20 tunnels. The starting point is at the village of Mokra Gora, where you will be able to see authentic houses as well as two small village churches (the small wooden church of St. Ilias The Prophet and the Church of Holy Ascension built in stone

at the end of the 17th century). The Sargan's Eight drives along a couple of places and goes through several stops where you can take a break and enjoy the scenery which abounds with thermal and healing springs, the most important being the White Waters spring -Bele Vode. The buildings of the train station have been restored to look exactly as in the year 1925 when the train first started its route.


Natural phenomena – The Caves

Speleology lovers – check out **Stopica Cave.** Located in the village of **Rozanstvo**, it represents one of the most beautiful caves in Serbia. It is 1,691 meters long and possesses beautiful features and cascades in limestone. The entrance is at 711 meters altitude and it is 35 meters wide. The cave consists of two caverns - an underground river course, and a spring cave, connected by the underground flow of the Trnavski Stream.

Potpecka cave—located near the town of Uzice, in the village of Potpece, with its 50m high and 12 m wide entrance is one of the largest in the Balkans. Because of the Orthodox symbols engraved in the walls, it is believed that the cave served as a hideout during the Ottoman occupation. After visiting the cave, you can enjoy a nice meal in the nearby ethno village of Zlakusa, also famous for tradition pottery making.



Uvac Resort



••••••

The fairy tale resort of Uvac offers various features. The lake of Uvac is 27 km long and 108 meters deep. The breathtaking panoramic view can be captured from Molitva (Prayer) point. The monastery of Uvac located in the Uvac canyon is a medieval place of worship. It dates back to the 12th century. Another symbol of the Uvac resort is the very unique and rare species of vultures –

the white headed vulture. This magnificent bird of prey with its 3 meters wingspan was very close to extinction. The conservation campaign that started some 20 years ago has proved to be very successful. Presently, the Uvac resort is the home to some 300 white headed vultures that are now flying free above the resort, as an unbeatable attraction for tourists and nature enthusiasts.

The National Park of Tara Mountain

If you are staying in Zlatibor, do not miss the opportunity to see the real natural beauty that is Tara mountain. It is such an enchanting and inspiring sight that it is difficult to describe it in words. Not even the super quality photo camera can capture the charms of this mild mountain.


The River Drina flows through the Tara resort, and is said to be one of the cleanest waters in Europe. The canyon of the Drina is the third deepest in the world. It is a fast river, perfect for various water sports such as white water rafting and kayaking. The famous Drina regatta is held every year in July. Lake Perucac on the Drina river is a true pearl, with 52 kilometers of shoreline. The 13th century monastery of Raca is located on the mountain slope, while at its foot flows one of the shortest rivers in Europe—the Vrelo River, also called the 'Year' as it is 365 meters long. You can take a break at the 'Vrelo' restaurant and enjoy the view from the summer terrace.

KOPAONIK

Largest ski resort



With 200 sunny days a year, the mountain of Kopaonik is usually called Sunny Mountain. It offers various opportunities for both winter and summer activities. Kopaonik offers more than 50 km of Alpine skiing runs, as well as 12 km for Nordic skiing. A real fun for fans is night skiing conveniently organized on the "little lake" run, and the snowboard park which

hosts numerous competitions. The ski center is well equipped with ski lifts of different kinds; and just in case, artificial snowing systems have been installed. If you are not a skier, but are a nature enthusiast, and regardless of the season, you can hop on the four-seater which will take you for a panoramic sightseeing tour.

Mystical Evergreen

The highest peak of Kopaonik is called Pancic peak (2017 m) in honor of the famous botany scientist in the 19th century, and first president of the Serbian Royal Academy, Josif Pancic. He has made tremendous contribution in the field of botany, and was most inspired by the mountain of Kopaonik where he made some of his most unique plant and tree discoveries.

He discovered the new species of conifer – the **Serbia Spruce**, later classified as Picea omorika (Pančić) Purkyne. To show his great love and affection towards the Serbian people, Josif Pancic had expressed his wish to be buried in Kopaonik. Honoring his request, the Serbian Academy of Science and Art erected the mausoleum of Josif Pancic on the highest peak, now called the Pancic Peak.

The Heavenly Chairs



Just below the highest peak of Pancic, the archaeological site of Heavenly chairs (Nebeske stolice) is located at 1,800 meters altitude. A real jewel, this is the site where an early Christian basilica from the 5th century AD was discovered. The archeological works uncovered the mosaic floor with geometrical motifs, typical of the period, while

the highlight is definitely the image of the peacock, an early Christian symbol of resurrection. Further discoveries uncovered older buildings – the Roman settlement from the 3rd century, with Roman coins, pieces of the ceramic and glass vessels from the Antique and Early Byzantine period.

Hot Springs and Spas

The valleys of Kopaonik abound with thermal springs. The water temperature of Josanicka Spa can reach as high as 78 C. Try to boil an egg, and you will be amazed how quickly you can have your breakfast ready! The Spa has a very long tradition in rheumatic healing; it dates back to the Ottoman times when the hamam was built. Still in use today, you should definitely try it for the utmost joy and relaxation. You can have fabulous entertainment in the agua park with two small artificial lakes. Take advantage of swimming in thermo-mineral

Lukovska Spa, located in the idyllic valley on the eastern slopes of the Kopaonik mountain, at the altitude of 681 m above sea level. The spa offers numerous mineral water springs at varying

temperatures. Enjoy the mild climate, and brisk and fresh mountain air.

The Prolom Spa is located in South Serbia, on the slopes of Radan Mountain. It is primarily known for its natural Prolom water, with medical and healing qualities. No matter whether you are here for a vacation or medical treatment, you will be dazzled by nature.

Kursumlijska Spa – the spa and thermal springs have been around since the Roman times. The remains of the old bath, the tombs, and the silver coins from the 3rd century, are all testaments that speak in favor of the fact that the Romans had used the springs for healing purposes.



The Fortresses



•••••

Maglic – the medieval fortress close to the town of Raska, on the right bank of Ibar River, is one of the most beautiful and best preserved fortresses in Serbia. Built in the 13th century by Serbian King Uros I, the fortress is a place where various events, take place especially in the summer time.

Koznik, the fortress with seven towers was built in the 14th century. It is located on the slopes of Kopaonik at 921 meters altitude, near the town of Aleksandrovac and is not easy accessible. Tradition says that the building materials were carried by the goats – therefore the name Koznik for the fortress; koza meaning goat. The fortress is well preserved and can be reached if you take a path through the wood up until the old town. If you start at the village of Koznica, it will take you some 45 minutes to get to the old town.

Monastery Tour

Visit some of the most important monasteries of Serbian Orthodoxy and spirituality: Studenica, Zica, and Gradac.

Studenica Monastery

represents the most beautiful architectural monument of the medieval Serbia. The relics of King Stefan, the First-Crowned, are preserved in the monastery as the most sacred treasure. The Monastery is on the UNESCO list of World Heritage sites.

Zica Monastery is one of the most outstanding Serbian monasteries. It was built in the early 13th century. The Monastery of Zica is the place where the first Serbian Kings were crowned.

Gradac Monastery was founded by Queen Jelena Anzujska (Helen Anjou), the wife of King Uros I in the 13th century. The predominant architectural influence is gothic. The Monastery keeps the marble sarcophagus where the Queen was buried.



Devil's Town



•••••

Located some 80 km from Kopaonik, this place is a definite must see. It is Serbia's natural landmark and Serbia's nominee for the Seven Wonders of Nature. The area features 202 stone formations, described as earth pyramids or towers, some of them being as much as 15 meters high. These rock formations were created by strong erosion of the soil during the intense volcanic

activity millions of years ago. Other phenomena include two springs of extremely acid water and high mineral content, where the level of some elements are 1000 times higher than in ordinary drinking water. The whole area around Devil's Town is so unrealistic and mystical, all set in an amazing surrounding — you will really feel you are in a different world.

Hilarious Ibar Rafting

The rapids of Ibar River are a challenge for the sailing lovers. A must see /do event is the 'Rafting without frontiers' activity which starts in Leposavic, Kosovo and ends up in Raska. The whole event is an outstanding manifestation of positive vibrations, and it finishes with the fabulous, mouth-watering beans stew, followed by a rock concert. The participants will enjoy the unique natural environment.

Another great lbar rafting event is 'Happy Rafting' and it starts right below the Maglic fortress some time in July, flows all the way to the town of Kraljevo, for 24 km of a hilarious ride. More than 1,000 boats and several thousands of river enthusiasts participate in this event


